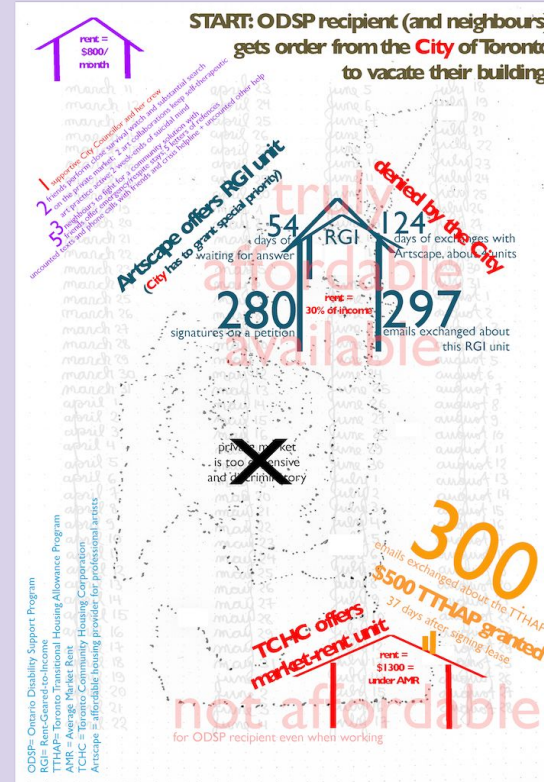
Those whose RGI is threatened by the end of a funding agreement are not offered another RGI unit, but are part of a priority group for COHB in the provincial guidelines.

When an ODSP recipient is forced out of his home by the City, the City denies access to RGI (next slide).

when an ODSP recipient is forced out of his home, even if it is by the City, they enter into a long crisis, with a high probability of suicidal thoughts and serious strain on the few friends available for support; they require the time of a large number of paid agencies and individuals (possibly Councillor and crew included);

if they get an offer of an empty RGI unit by a dedicated provider they qualify for, the City denies access and forces them to continue their journey of hundreds of emails to get TTHAP.
