Petition Regarding claude wittmann's Dehousing

Following the continued displacement of the artists living at 17 Paton Road, despite an <u>earlier</u> <u>petition</u>, we the undersigned declare our support for claude wittmann in his request to be assigned the Rent-Geared-to-Income (RGI) unit currently available at Wychwood Barns.

We believe that to consider claude as an exceptional case in an exceptional context and facing an unprecedented situation is justified.

The whole Province has been in a state of emergency for a while and still is. He is dehoused by the type of orders from the City that no housing advocates have seen served in Toronto before. This is quite exceptional already. He has led his neighbours into and contributed hours and hours to the hard work done to try to save his building as affordable in Toronto. That could deserve the gesture of allowing him what he says he needs. His landlady recently threatened to change the locks on all units at 17 Paton Road. He is an aging, immigrant transman who lives with a multi-faceted Disability. He is an ODSP recipient with a very low income, currently unemployed, the reason for which an RGI unit would be perfect. He is statistically more at risk of discrimination by landlords and of experiencing verbal or physical violence in all housing that is not a safe long-term home where he has community. His health is affected. He has found what he needs. Artscape agrees. He has been on their waiting list for more than 7 years. It is time to see a human life.

The true doctor in this situation is the City itself. The City can decide to not add trauma. We request that you overturn your decision to deny him the RGI Unit at Artscape Wychwood Barns.
